## Special Interest Perry Jefferson

### *Air force Officer Missing In Action From Vietnam War is Identified.*



The Department of Defense POW/Missing Personnel Office (DPMO) announced today that the remains of a U.S. serviceman, missing in action from the Vietnam War, have been identified and will be returned to his family for burial with full military honors.

He is Perry H. Jefferson, U.S. Air force, of Denver, Co. He will be buried April 3, 2008 in Arlington National cemetery

near Washington, D.C.

April 3 will be the 39th anniversary of his being listed as missing after failing to return from a flight.

Perry was an Intel officer with the 120th Tactical Fighter Squadron.

Airlift to Andrews AFB, MD will depart 2 Apr 2008 and return 3 Apr 2008, after the service. The Colony South Motel has offered a rate of \$129/night before taxes. Group transportation

will be by military bus. Individual car rental will be optional. Those that deployed to Phan Rang will have first priority. If you would like more details or are interested in participating, please contact Jan Love via the OSOTMG@comcast.net E-Mail account and she will get back with you ASAP.

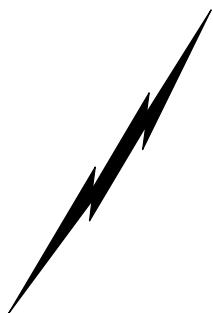
Parking at the commissary is very limited. The south parking lot will be closed for about 45 days, while soil that possibly contains asbestos is removed. You must enter the parking lot
