Here goes while I have the time. I enjoyed talking to you this morning. I had many happy years while in the CONG.

My older brother Joe was in, then I joined up, then our younger brother Roscoe joined. Joe was going up that Sunday morning; he talked to the pilot and asked if I could go up. Joe gave me a bucket, so in case I got sick, I wouldn't make a mess. After flying around for about one half hour we landed and I joined the CONG. I did enjoy it and a little money to go with it.

I had seven sisters and the 3 of us boys. A large German family and we all got along and did what Mama or Daddy told us to do.

My first encampment was right at the old field (Lowry). One summer we went to Ft Sill, OK; another year we went to Boise, ID; and the other summers we stayed at home base.

In 1939 I joined the U.S. Navy. My 1st ship was a repair ship out of Pearl. After I made my 3rd class rating I transferred to the USS ERICSSON a Destroyer, we convoyed to Reykjavik Iceland. Then I went to school again and transferred to the USS WISCONSIN, a large battleship. Our big job in WWII was to take out the 2 large steel mills that were left in Japan. When that was done the War was over.

I returned to Denver, CO and went to work for the Public Service Co (Excel) building substations and power plants.

I was married to My Beloved Wife Julie for 54 years and we traveled the world. One nice trip was in 1956 when we went to the Holy Land and served communion in the Garden of Gethsemane on a Sat afternoon. We traveled all over CO and other states before Julie passed away and I once again returned to Denver.
